The conference will be held in a hybrid form (face-to-face and online). The subject of the two-day conference will be the presentation and exchange of knowledge (debates, lectures) on solutions concerning the future of agriculture in Poland and Europe.

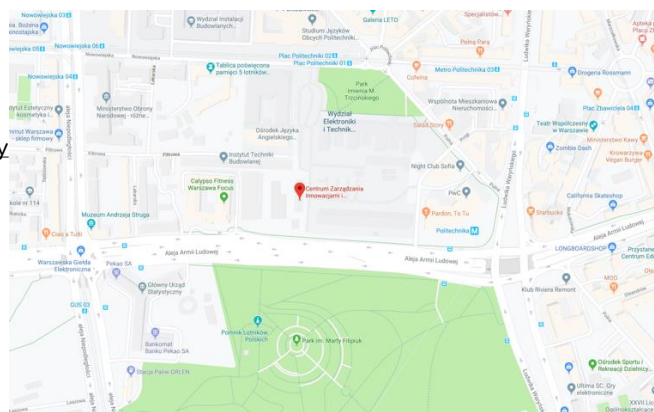
Polish and European agriculture is facing many difficult economic, social and environmental challenges, the solution of which is crucial for the future of food security. The most important goal is to ensure the profitability and competitiveness of agricultural production in Poland and in Europe in line with the urgent need to take environmentally and climate-friendly measures and to guarantee sustainable development of rural areas. The way in which the agricultural sector operates is also increasingly influenced by consumers' expectations of high-quality food production in line with the protection of public health, nature, soil, water and climate, and animal welfare.

The conference will present topics related to the Common Agricultural Policy, organic farming and agroecology, including agricultural practices affecting the maintenance of soil in good agricultural condition and preventing escape of nutrients to surface waters and the Baltic Sea. Topics related to animal welfare or reduction of pesticides in agricultural production will also be discussed.
