



# Loodushoiu Fond and wetlands



#### Target:

Preserve biodiversity, preserve forest conservation functions and provide new opportunities for wetland conservation, and establish lasting collaboration between the community, business and landowner.

#### Objective 1:

With private sector co-funding, provide nature conservation and wetland conservation outside protected areas, ensuring the restoration of drinking water and fresh water supplies.

#### Objective 2:

Bring partners together by introducing nature conservation activities as part of business activities, encouraging collaboration and behavioural change.

Timeline: 40 years


Estimated amount of carbon credit: 184 tCO2eq

Potential area restored: 23 hectares





## Briefly about possible private land project

Activity		Minimum budget
Expert opinion	Project for restoring wetland	- 1000€
Filling the ditch	Closing the ditches that are in the wetland	- 4000€
Digging ditch	30 eur/m roundabout ditch	- 20 000€
Carbon credits	184 tCO2eq (price 50 €/tonns)	- 9200€
Total for the restoration renovator		- 34 200 €





#### But

- Neighbours?
- Would it actually improve anything, as it was dug already in 1960s
- For third parties carbon credits are sexy but not contributing to nature

1 000 ha peat extraction areas


### Today in Estonia

State Forest Agency has restored 17 000 ha of peatland areas,


